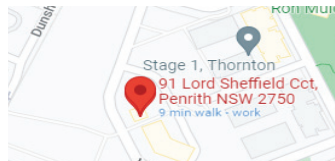

How long have you lived in Thornton?

I will have been here for 2 years in November.

How did you end up here – what attracted you to the area?

My friends, Michele and Ian moved here before I did, and I loved the area. They suggested I look at a brochure of a beautiful new building being created and eventually I decided I wanted to live there.

What do you do for work?

I teach music and I'm the director of BIJA Yoga Studio, Penrith.

What do you like to do in your neighbourhood when you find some free time?

Thornton is developing a village-feel and I love this about the neighbourhood. I also love all the little pockets of grass and the different walkways in the neighbourhood. And I absolutely love that the train station is just a few blocks away! If you're coming home from town late at night you feel as if you've gotten off the train and straight back in your living room.

What has surprised you most about living in Thornton?

How much I WANT to walk around the neighbourhood and to/from my yoga studio. Where I used to live was just as close but not as ... well-designed as Thornton.

What is the best feature of living in Thornton?

Two things: the sheer diversity of people who live here (and how friendly people are), and how easy it is to get to everywhere from here.

When you are not running classes at your business will Thornton locals see you in one of the parks practicing your Yoga?

I'm very lucky to have a huge balcony to practice on during the warmer months and yes I have been known to teach friends in public spaces in Thornton, such as the landing on the canal behind my apartment building.

How long have you been open in Thornton?

We opened our doors to the Thornton community nine months ago. It seems amazing now to think we opened when COVID was still causing so much uncertainty.

How did you decide to specialise in profiteroles?

This is actually a franchise business, so we had seen the unique concept was successful in other areas. We thought the growing community here in Thornton would support something a little different like this and lucky for us that has proved to be true!

What do you love about operating your business here in Thornton?

I love that it is so multi-cultural. The local community is really interesting and diverse. Also, this is such a clean environment. It is new and smart and that makes it a really appealing place to come to work and it fits perfectly with the idea of our business. We offer our customers clean, new, fresh, appealing food so it all just works.

And your customers? Do you have a few regulars who like to indulge with a sweet tooth?

Yes, we do have regular customers. It is a source of pride that I can remember the regular orders of at least 30 to 40 of our regulars. It is nice to see them each day.

What are your most popular items that any new customer should definitely try?

Well as our name suggests we are known for our profiterole cakes, but I would also recommend trying our fruit cocktails that we make with Ashta, which is a popular Middle Eastern cream. I should point out that we cater for those with a sweet tooth but we also have an extensive savoury menu, so we have something for everyone.
