Opening the Door to Thornton Business Matt and Mark - Rusty Penny Brewing



How long have you been in operation?

We started as a homebrew supply store in 2016 but then built and opened our own brewery in 2018 around the corner in Dean Place. We were excited to open the doors to our expanded Rusty Penny Brewery in Coreen Ave in February 2022. It still offers more space but the same authentic, immersive brewery experience where you can drink the beer while the brew masters make it around you!

Why did you decide to specialise in beer?

Mark and I have been homebrewers since 2007 and just love craft beer. We would regularly travel to the breweries in Marrickvillle and wanted to bring the magic of that experience to people back home in Penrith.

What do you love about operating your business here?

We love servicing our local community. It brings us a lot of joy and to see people enjoy the products that we make locally.

How well do you know your customers?

All our customers from the original Dean Place site are more like friends than customers and it is great they have followed us to this expanded space. It is much bigger and it is really exciting that we are welcoming so many new faces. It might take a bit of time but we are really looking forward to getting to know everyone by name.

What is your most popular drink?

Our most popular beer is probably The Nepean "the beer of Penrith". It's an Australian pale ale and not overly hoppy so it appeals to both craft and non-craft beer drinkers.

Is there a drink that you think people should definitely try?

People should definitely try our seasonal and limited-edition beers. That's where we really push the limits of what beer is. We recently teamed up with a local coffee roaster, Underground Coffee Roasters, to brew a toasted coconut and coffee pale ale. It was a very fun beer.
