The big day is nearly here! Finally!!!!

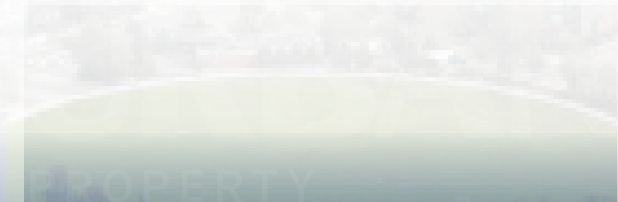
Saturday 11th March is going to be a fantastic opportunity to come together for some fun, frivolity and celebration.
